Langara's <u>General Education Diploma</u> provides students who do not plan to pursue university-level study a diverse selection of post-secondary courses. Students gain foundational knowledge in multiple areas of study as well as an introduction to a variety of theories. Through the program, students develop critical thinking skills and research skills.
