Rachel Ramsden was coming off an impressive game last weekend where she scored two goals against UNBC. This Richmond product continued right where she left off as the Falcons faced the Kwantlen Eagles and Capilano Blues. On Saturday vs the Eagles, Ramsden opened the scoring for the Falcons in the 39th minute on a superb one timer low to the far corner, just inside the post. She had timed her run perfectly and received a well placed pass from Taryn Lim, beat her defender to the pass and calmly slotted the ball home. With the score tied 1-1 midway through the second half, Ramsden would make a similar run and again was rewarded with a fantastic ball, this time from midfielder Lauren Hendriks. She collected the ball about 25 yards out, took a touch and hammered a low drive which beat the Kwantlen keeper low to the far post yet again.

On Sunday, the Falcons would face the Blues. The best scoring chance in the first half came on a penetrating pass from Ramsden that sent Katie Tarrant in on a 1 vs 1 with the goalie. The Cap goalie would make the save keeping the score 0-0. In the 2nd half with the score 1-0 for the Falcons, Ramsden put the game out of reach for the Blues when she fired a bullet from 30 yards out that beat the diving goalkeeper only to have the ball ricochet off the post across the face of goal. Tarrant was there to fire in the rebound and give the Falcons a convincing 2-0 advantage. Ramsden continued to dominate the center of the park for the remaining 20 minutes as she controlled the ball and provided excellent service to wide midfielders and strikers.

Langara enters the final weekend of league play sitting on top of Pool B and 1st overall.
