RICHMOND'S ELLIOT MASON SIGNS WITH LANGARA BASKETBALL FOR 2010/11

(Vancouver, BC) – The Langara College Men's Basketball program is pleased to announce the commitment of Richmond standout Elliot Mason (J.N. Burnett Secondary). This announcement was made today by the Department of Athletics and Intramurals at Langara College.

Mason, who stands 6'5" and has played both small forward and point guard this season, is currently averaging 22 points, 12 rebounds and 6 assists per game for the Breakers. "Elliot's versatility allows him to play a number of positions" commented Langara's Head Coach Jake McCallum. "This coupled with his athletic ability should allow him to flourish at the next level. He'll be a great addition to the Falcon roster."

In choosing to attend Langara Mason will be joining a roster that includes three other Richmond products including Lambert Punsalan (Hugh Boyd '08), Mark Kol (R.C. Palmer '09) and Matt Madewan (R.C. Palmer '09). Langara has a longstanding tradition of being the destination and stepping stone for many of Richmond's high school grads highlighted in recent years by Kyle Watson (R.A. McMath), who transferred to UBC, and even more recently Clint Wickham (H.J. Cambie) who transferred to Trinity Western University after being named the BCCAA Player of the Year and a CCAA All-Canadian.
