

SEWING & FASHION ARTS VFDE 1017 Sewing Level 2 – Supply List

VFDE 1017 Sewing Level 2:

Use the knowledge gained in Sewing Level 1 (VFDE 1006) and acquire more sewing skills while constructing your choice of blouse or dress shirt including set-in sleeves, collars & cuffs, darts, placket openings, buttons & buttonholes. Please come prepared to the first class with paper and pen, basic sewing kit and a sewing pattern for a blouse or dress shirt along with suitable fabric to complete the project. Approximate cost of additional supplies \$20-\$80, depending on your fabric/pattern choice. Pre-requisite: Sewing Level 1 or equivalent. Course may be applied as credit towards the Langara CS at VSB Sewing and Fashion Arts Certificate.

Supplies

Basic Sewing Kit:

Fabric Scissors
Tape Measure
Pins
Seam Ripper

Thread
Chalk (yellow shows up on most fabrics)
Paper and Pen

Optional:

Sewing Machine (with foot control and required power cords)

Pattern & Fabric:

Pattern: Personal Choice of blouse or dress shirt.

Pattern should have:

- Darts
- Set-in, Shirt style sleeves
- Collar & Collar Stand
- Cuffs & Sleeve Plackets
- Buttons & Buttonholes

Pattern Examples:

- Sewaholic Patterns – Granville Shirt (womens)
- Thread Theory Patterns - Fairfield Shirt (mens)

Fabric: Follow pattern instructions for fabric type suggestions, and amount of fabric required. These instructions and suggestions are generally found on the back of the pattern envelope.

General suggested fabrics: 100% Cotton, Shirting, Oxford, Chambray, Lawn, Poplin, Flannel

Extras: Additional supplies that might be required such as interfacing, buttons, etc will be discussed in class.

*Prior to cutting fabric out, fabric will need to be pre-treated. This will be discussed during the first class.
Please hold off on cutting out pattern or fabric until after first class.*
