<b>Accessibility Services</b>	Accessibility Services works with all students with disabilities to arrange appropriate support services on a case-by-case basis. Students are required to register with Accessibility Services, provide appropriate documentation, and sign a disclosure/consent form. Students can visit Accessibility Services for more information and book an intake appointment. It is recommended that students make these arrangements 2-3 months prior to term start.
<b>Athletics &amp; Intramurals</b>	<p>Students can show their ID Card for drop-in sessions in the gym.</p> <p>Locker rental and towel service.</p> <p>Student enrolled in Continuing Studies programs are not eligible for Varsity sports teams, except for the LEAP program.</p>
<b>Student Engagement</b>	<p>Students can access the following programs and activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student clubs</li> <li>• VOLT program</li> <li>• Campus wide events hosted by Student Engagement</li> </ul>
<b>Co-op &amp; Career Development</b>	<p>The Co-op program is not open to students who are enrolled in Continuing Studies programs, although certain programs do incorporate work integrated learning into their curriculum.</p> <p>All students enrolled Continuing Studies programs can access the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Career events and workshops</li> <li>• Job board (C3)</li> </ul>
<b>Counselling</b>	<p>Students can access one session for resourcing and referrals. Students in full-time programs may access on-going counselling.</p> <p>All Continuing Studies students are welcome to attend drop-ins, workshops, and course planning.</p>
<b>Financial Aid</b>	<p>Students enrolled in Continuing Studies may be eligible for student loans and grants, or other financial aid supports. Please review the Cost of Study to see if your program is eligible for student loans and grants or contact financial aid if you wish to learn about what opportunities for support may be available to you.</p>
<b>Health Services</b>	<p>Students can access medical services on campus. Although a valid BC Care Card is expected, service will not be refused to any student.</p>

<b>Indigenous Education Services</b>	<p>Students that self-identify as Indigenous have access to the following programs and activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Workshops and information sessions</li> <li>• Counselling – educational, personal and career</li> <li>• Advocacy and liaison support with band/tribal administration, sponsoring agencies, community resources, College programs and/or services, etc.</li> <li>• Assistance with the transition into Langara and/or transfer to other post-secondary institutions upon completion of studies at Langara College</li> </ul>

<b>Langara Student Success Course</b>	<p>Students enrolled in the following full-time Continuing Studies programs are required to take the Langara Student Success Course (LSSC).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Advanced Accounting (Diploma only)</li> <li>• Supply Chain &amp; Logistics</li> <li>• Real Estate (Diploma)</li> <li>• Construction Standards</li> <li>• Real Property</li> <li>• 2D Animation &amp; Digital Art</li> <li>• 3D Animation for Game, Film &amp; Visual Effects</li> <li>• Health Safety and Environmental Compliance program</li> </ul> <p>For part-time Continuing Studies programs, completion of the LSSC may be encouraged by the Program Coordinator, but it is not mandatory.</p>
