Notes to FTE Enrolment Report

Year ended March 31, 2012, with comparative figures for 2011

1. Basis of FTE calculation

FTE enrolment is calculated based on instructions contained in the Student FTE Enrolment Reporting Manual provided by the Ministry of Advanced Education of the Province of British Columbia.

The method for calculating FTE enrolment is based on course credits, or, where credits are not available, student contact hours. Student course registrations are first assigned to programs and FTE's are then calculated based on program divisors. These divisors are based on expected course loads for full time students as formally prescribed by the College.

2. Report presentation

In accordance with Ministry requirements to include all instructional activities, this report includes enrolments for international students. These enrolments are shown separately as they are not funded by the Province of British Columbia.
