Students who intend to pursue the BBA Accounting program at Langara are also encouraged to register for the coursesbelow during the first two years of the BBA. Admission to the BBA requires a minimum 2.33 CGPA.

English Prerequisite

¹ One of the following: a minimum 67% in English Studies 12, Literary Studies 12, English First Peoples 12, or equivalent; a university-level English or communications course for which Langara awards transfer credit; or a minimum "C" grade in ENGL 1120; or a minimum "C-" grade in ENGL 1121, or an "S" grade in one of ENGL 1107, 1108, or 1110. LET with a minimum Level 3; LEAP 8, LPI with a minimum 26 on the essay and one of 5 in English usage, 5 in sentence structure, or 10 in reading comprehension.
