LEARNING OR MASTERY GOALS

- Main and fundamental goal is increasing one's mastery.
- Failure is only a feedback device on how you should correct your shortcomings and to improve yourself for the next round.

PERFORMANCE GOALS

This type of goal is almost entirely focused on the grades that I get versus what I have actually learned and how this increases my knowledge for the long-term:

 In general, these types of students are more focused on approval by others, rather than focusing on selfimprovements.
