### **KEEP TRACK OF:**

- Relationships between key concepts, topics, etc. in the chapter and to items you learned in class or in past readings.

- Write these on a paper or your computer/laptop.
- As you read the text, think of questions ("what", "why", and "how") that deepen your understanding of the concepts.
