Time Needed for Your Courses (Part 1)

CALCULATE YOUR TOTAL HOURS FOR EACH COURSE

For every class you have about four hours of lectures each week.

For every hour of lecture you need to study for at least two hours (and this is the bare minimum...)

- In-class lecture time: 4 hours a week
- Study & prep time: 4 x 2 = 8 hours a week
- Total commitment to a course (min.):
 4 hours + 8 hours = 12 hours a week

1 COURSE = 1 X 12 = 12 HOURS WEEK Like a part-time job.

2 COURSES = 2 X 12 = 24 HOURS A WEEK Not exactly a full-time job, but busy; even part-time work in your spare time may prove to be demanding.

3 COURSES = 3 X 12 = 36 HOURS A WEEK Like a full-time job. Extra work not recommended as this may overwhelm your available time.

4 COURSES = 4 X 12 = 48 HOURS A WEEK Busier than a full-time job.

5 COURSES = 5 X 12 = 60 HOURS A WEEK Similar hours to a stock broker; almost like two jobs per week.
